 - Located 30min South-West of city


Getting Around

- Taxi's and Ride-share companies are plentiful in Chicago in addition to a robust public transit system
 of "el" trains, busses & bike share
- There is paid public parking at 31st street harbor for assembly & in the millennium park garage next to the Chicago Yacht Club. There is limited parking at the Chicago Yacht Club and one spot per team will be made available if possible.
- Parking at hotels can be very expensive. Teams flying in and not bringing a "team car" should consider not renting a car, booking one of the many hotels within walking distance of the Chicago Yacht Club, and otherwise using taxi's & ride-share.

Chicago Overall Map






- Park Road Trailers in daily trailer parking during assembly

Dockage- Monroe Harbor


- 1) Please bring fenders and dock lines to allow for rafting of boats

If you are keeping your boat rigged up in Chicago between the two events we have secured a portion of fenced parking lot for the period




<u>"Outer" Race Area</u>
